INNOVATION

- Animal alternatives including milk alternative and meat alternative products. We are also seeing fermentation technology proposed to create animal like proteins. Cornell has the resources in lab space and pilot manufacturing faciliteis to assist businesses further their development of these products.
- Whey product, specifically acid whey. Acid whey is a large waste product from Greek yogurt manufacturing. Companies have been developing products to turn that waste into viable products on the market (i.e. probiotic drinks, probiotic pops, etc).

ACCESS TO COMPETITIVE INCENTIVES & PROGRAMS

Tax-based incentives, resources and training for entrepreneurs and businesses looking to go global, industry/university partnerships fostering the development of innovative technologies and products, and the financial support needed to help businesses grow are just some of these advantages.

TAX-BASED INCENTIVES

All forms of tax incentives that enable savings and provide cost advantages to business.

OPERATIONAL SUPPORT

Programs offering assistance or training to promote more competitive businesses.

INNOVATION DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT

Financial incentives to foster university collaboration, research and innovation.

GROWTH SUPPORT

Funds, loans and other means of financial support to stimulate business growth.

THE EXCELSIOR JOBS PROGRAM

Firms in the Excelsior Jobs Program may qualify for five fully refundable tax credits. Businesses claim the credits over a benefit period of up to 10 years as established in the preliminary schedule of benefits. To earn credits, firms must first meet and maintain established job and investment thresholds. The minimum number of jobs for agribusiness firms to be eligible for the Excelsior Jobs Program is 5 net new jobs.

CORNELL CENTER OF EXCELLENCE FOR FOOD AND AGRICULTURE

The Center of Excellence for Food and Agriculture at Cornell AgriTech serves as a hub connecting businesses and entrepreneurs with the services they need to succeed. The Center of Excellence works with partners across the state to increase the size and scope of the food and agriculture economy in New York by fostering the growth of new companies, new products, and existing businesses.

JOBS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (JDA) DIRECT LOAN PROGRAM

The JDA Direct Loan Program provides direct loans for the growth of manufacturing and other eligible businesses within New York State by assisting in financing a portion of the cost of acquiring and renovating existing buildings or constructing new buildings or for purchasing machinery and equipment.

NYPA RECHARGE NY

Through the ReCharge NY program, qualifying businesses and nonprofits statewide can potentially lower their energy costs by using specially allocated NYPA power which is set aside by the state government and the NYPA board for economic support. NYPA operates several hydroelectric facilities across New York State.
